## “Girls In STEM” Program March 25, 6-8pm @ Mt St. Joseph University

### **Student Program: “Take a Deep Breath – Respiration Lab”**

This interactive experience involves exploring the anatomy and physiology of the respiratory system. Students will interact with inflated cow lungs, respiratory models, microscope slides, and a virtual anatomy software system (Anatomage) to develop an understanding of the structure and function of the respiratory organs. Special focus will be given to pathologies, including how substances affect the respiratory system (especially cigarettes and e-cigarettes/vaping).

### **Parent Program “Mentoring Your Future Scientist”**

This interactive session will explore the myths, realities, and possibilities for girls in the sciences and math. Join us for a parent-to-parent conversation about how to nurture curiosity and learning.

## YOUTH & ADULT JOB OPPORTUNITY



The Western Baseball Conference (WBC) is seeking umpires for the 2020 baseball season. The WBC season runs from March 28, 2020 through the end of June. Umpire training classes are tentatively scheduled to be held on the Saturday mornings of February 29, March 7 and March 14 from 9:00am – 12:00pm at Our Lady of Victory cafeteria. On-field sessions are tentatively scheduled for March 20, 21, and 22 at Our Lady of the Visitation fields.

- Umpires must be at least a freshman in high school and have reliable transportation to and from games.
- No prior experience as an umpire is required, but a working knowledge of baseball is strongly recommended.
- New umpires are required to attend each of the three classroom sessions and at least one of the on-field sessions.
- The cost for the training is \$20 for new umpires.
- Umpire fees will start at \$40 per game for the 2020 season.
