**TITLE ONE:** During the 2020-21 school year, a total of 57 students participated in the K-4 grade Title 1 reading program. These students met the following objectives:

1. 100% read 20 or more books during the school year
2. 93% improved classroom performance and work habits as measured by the pre and post surveys completed by their classroom teacher

3. 98% showed improvements in reading skills based on pre and post testing data
